Napa County families and the folks at Cope Family Center are grinning ear to ear thanks to Dr. Adrian Fenderson, his staff and patients. Through the Smiles for Life Program, Dr. Fenderson, Jeannie Fenderson, Laura Hooker, Diane Pirie, Diane Wise, and Colleen Beasley brightened people's smiles and raised \$4,000 for Cope Family Center. Founded in 1972, Cope Family Center is a nonprofit organization dedicated to supporting parents and nurturing children through parent education, family support services, and child advocacy programs.

Dr. Fenderson presented the check to Director Joelle Gallagher at a festive gathering hosted at Copia for Cope Family Center donors and volunteers in September. This \$4,000 investment provided by Dr. Fenderson and staff will benefit Napa families directly by allowing Cope Family Center to provide parenting classes for 50 families, emergency aid and drop-in crisis counseling for 15 families, and a year's worth of home visits for one family.
